#### **Program Presentation**

### "What Did They Know? When Did They Know It? Grandrapidians and the Holocaust"

Rob Franciosi is Professor of English and Honors at Grand Valley State University. His work on the Holocaust includes *Elie Wiesel: Conversations*, the memoir *Good Morning* by Grand Rapids survivor Joseph Stevens, and articles on such writers as John Hersey, Anne Frank, and Art Spiegelman. Besides teaching courses on the Holocaust, he has conducted workshops at the Holocaust Memorial Center in Farmington Hills, escorted student groups to sites in Germany and Poland, and participated in study seminars in Eastern Europe, Israel, and at the Holocaust Research Institute at Royal Holloway, University of London, and most recently spent two months in Europe doing research for a project with the working title of *Stumbling Upon Strangers: A Post -Holocaust Memoir*.
